Our idyllic family run holiday park is situated within 14 acres of secluded grounds, surrounded by open countryside. We are located in the valley of the Stenbury and St. Martin's Downs, a designated Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and an ideal spot for walking, bird-watching and horse-riding.

For walkers and cyclists there are an excellent network of footpaths and cycle paths which can be accessed within minutes from the park. If you prefer relaxing on the beach, we are only a short car journey to the famous coves and beaches of Shanklin, Sandown and Ventnor, where you can enjoy sunbathing, swimming, sailing, windsurfing and hang-gliding.

If you want a break from the Island's many beaches, but still want to make a splash, we have a large sheltered outdoor heated swimming pool and small toddlers' pool (open from Whitsun week to early September). For those not quite ready to sample the Island's wide range of watersports, we hold swimming galas and scuba diving lessons during peak season.

If you have energy left after visiting the Island's many attractions we have a children's play park and miniature crazy golf for enjoyment.

Our café offers a selection of home-made food, and a poolside patio provides the opportunity for alfresco dining. A takeaway service is also available.

Spacious and comfortable, The Orchard Lodge consists of one double and one twin bedroom, and is centrally heated and fully inclusive. The lounge has a colour TV with Freeview and is combined with the dining area and kitchen, and a spacious open-plan design for easy access. The kitchen is fully equipped with an electric cooker, microwave, fridge with freezer compartment, toaster and kettle, and all utensils and crockery are provided. The bathroom has a basin, toilet and walk-in shower. Level pathways surround the lodge for easy access.

Orchard Lodge



Our light and spacious apartments are conveniently situated above the bar & entertainment area, both are suitable for up to six guests. Both are centrally heated and fully inclusive, with one double, one twin and one bunk-bedroom. The bathrooms have a full size bath with mixer shower taps, a basin and toilet. The full-sized modern kitchens are generously equipped with electric cooker, microwave, 'fridge only', toaster, kettle and all utensils and crockery are provided. Both have spacious lounges with TV and Freeview channels. Dining areas are situated in the lounge of Folly East, and in the kitchen of Folly West.

Both apartments have light and relaxing decor, and feature all the fixtures and fittings you expect from modern accommodation.

All of our static caravans are situated within a secluded walled orchard, which was designed by the famous Capability Brown. This area is traffic-free, providing peace and quiet for adults and safety for children. Parking is in the main car park. Trolleys are provided to transport luggage.

The Orchard Lodge is sited within the peaceful and unspoilt walled orchard once part of Appuldurcombe House. All the rooms are decorated in calm, modern style and come complete with all the home comforts.



The holiday park was originally part of the grounds of the nearby historic House. The old walled orchard now contains our 40 static caravans. You may choose from either 4 or 6 berth caravans, varying from luxurious with central heating to modest with gas or electric heaters, there are a selection of units to cater for everyone's requirements. Each caravan is equipped with a toilet, shower, fridge with freezer compartment, toaster, cooker with grill and a microwave in selected units. All caravans have flatscreen TVs with Freeview channels.

Touring & Camping

The front orchard is situated within a natural enclosure of fruit trees and is set aside as a tranquil area for walkers and hikers



Our Touring, Motorhome and Tenting amenities are situated within sheltered grassland with upland views of the Stenbury Downs. This area is split into three sections where a variety of pitches are available. All are numbered with electric hook-up, and are easily accessible via hard roads. On the main field there are; Standard grass, grass with shared water point, Super pitches on grass or hardstanding which incorporates a grass section.

A tranquil meadow area is adjacent, this is divided into two areas; Meadow Bluebell is one section; and has pitches which are hardstanding incorporating a grass section with shared water points. Meadow Bluebell is located by a stream, and a variety of animals frequent this area, such as; Moorhens, Ducks, Rabbits, Badgers and Pheasants, a lovely place for wildlife viewing.

Meadow Crocus is the second section; and has various types of pitches, from grass with shared water point, to Super pitches on grass or hardstanding incorporating a grass section. Meadow Crocus is on the higher level and overlooks the recreational area, where guests can picnic or play games.

The toilet block is very modern and built to a high specification, and has easy access throughout. The access friendly bathroom is situated within the same complex and has a wet room with grab rails, low level sink and toilet. The washing up area is located under a canopy on the south of the building, so the morning washing up duties can be done in the sunshine. There is also a recycling area situated on the North side of the building.



Queen Victoria's favourite holiday residence, Osborne House in East Cowes, and the quaint thatched cottages of Shanklin Old Village are just two highlights of the Island's rich heritage.





Travel directions from ferry ports

From any ferry port head to Newport, and take A3020 turning off towards Shanklin and Ventnor. Travel through Blackwater and onto Rookley, Godshill and Sandford. Once you reach Whiteley Bank roundabout turn right towards Wroxall village.

Travel past the Donkey Sanctuary and into the village of Wroxall. Travel along St. John's Road and then take the right turning into Appuldurcombe Road. The entrance to reception is the second turning on the right 150 yards up the hill.
